**BELGIUM BOYS ARE NOW CONSCRIPTED**

HAVRE, Sept. 25.—The German military authorities at Bruges, Belgium, are conscripting forcibly all the boys and men of that city between the ages of fourteen and sixty to work in munition factories and shipyards. The rich and the poor, shopkeepers and workmen, all are being taken, only the school teachers, doctors and priests escaping. The Germans virtually conducted raids in the city, according to reports received here seizing men in their homes, in the streets and in all public places. The provincial committee has been ordered by the Germans to release seventy-five per cent. of its staff.

**SPLENDID PIECE OF ROAD.**—A gentleman from Miscouche who was one of the visitors to the Exhibition informs The Guardian that a wonderful improvement has been effected on the Western Road between Miscouche and Wellington. This road has been notorious since time immemorial as the "corduroy Road," and no one remembers when it could safely be traversed except when smoothed down by a generous fall of snow. Within the past month this road has been transformed into a splendid road, the "corduroy" being buried under a bed of brush covered with a layer of clay, raising the roadway about a foot above its original level. When it is remembered that this clay had to be hauled a distance of nearly two miles the magnitude of the undertaking will be realized. The credit for this splendid work is due to Hon. James McNeill, the efficient Commissioner of Public Works and his able coadjutor, Mr. Gilbert LeClair, (better known as Gil Tom) the Road Master for the Miscouche end of the undertaking and to Mr. Joseph E. McNeill the Road Master for the Wellington end.
