ARREARS OF TAXES NOTICE TO DEFAULTERS

Notice is hereby given that the Act passed by the Legislature in 1907, to provide a more speedy and simple method for the collection of arrears of Taxes, will be put into force at once for the collection of Arrears of 1906 and all previous years. The new Act does not require proceedings to be taken against the land, the advertisement of the same in the morning of Final Notices to Defaulters; and it gives the Government the additional power, after the Tax is one month over due, of suing in any Court, and of levying on all goods and chattes found on the premises or in possession of the party sued. Where there are no goods and chattes, or not sufficient to levy on, proceedings will be taken against the land under the old Act as heretofore.

The new Act, as well as the old, declares all taxes to be "Crown debts," having priority over all other Claims, Judgments, Mortgages, Bills of Sale, etc. All Taxes will be sued for in the name of the King.

Persons in Arrears for Land, Road or Income Tax are requested to make immediate payment to save expenses.

LESSON IX.—JUNE 2. MOSES CALLED TO DELIVER ISRAEL. Exodus 3:1-4. Mo. n. verses 2, 3, 4. GOLDEN TEXT.

And he said, Certainly I will be with thee.—Exodus 3:12.

EXPLANATIONS. Vs. 1-2. Kept.—For years he led the life of a shepherd. Let—in a arch of pasture. Desert.—The plain. Hord.—Where God especially revealed himself. This was a mountain range, of which Sinai was a single peak. Angel.—The voice from the bush so strangely appearing. Bush.—An acacia plant, its burning and yet being unconsumed, was a symbol of Israel in exile.

Vs. 3-4. Said.—To himself. Turn.—Joyously, and an honest spirit of inquiry. Why.—The flame was bright, but the bush was not affected. Saw.—That he was open and ready for His message. Said.—Nearly two hundred years have passed since God spoke to Jacob. Her.—A prompt response, indicating readiness to obey.

Vs. 5-6. Said.—God would teach him reverence. Shoes.—According to a general custom. I am.—This statement proved God to be merciful and faithful. Hid.—Conscious of his sin, weakness and unworthiness before God.

Vs. 7-9. Seen.—Continued now for eighty years, the affliction had done its needed work. Know.—God's "seen," "hear," and "know," show how thoroughly He was acquainted with their need. Down.—In leading deliberate purpose. The language—"in an agony of prayer," shows that God had been praying for the people of Israel, and good in the sense of being fruitful. Canaanites.—Most prominent, and giving name to the land. Cry.—Not only does God know, but the people plead for deliverance.

Vs. 10-14. Sent.—God knew His work and knew His worker. My people.—The message is given fully and almost abruptly. Said.—Moses has many excuses for declining the work: (1) Personal unfitness, (2) Ignorance and rebellion of the people, (3) strength of the enemy, (4) opposition of Pharaoh, God said—God graciously answers every excuse, and strengthens his faith and courage by promises of help and presence.

BLACK HUNDREDS TURN'D LOOSE

On May 23.—The Black Hundreds took advantage of the funeral today of the three police officials assassinated at the Central Police Barracks yesterday to renew their attacks on the Jews. The whole Jewish population became terrified; all the streets were closed and the streets were almost deserted. Fifty-three persons were taken to the hospital suffering from broken heads, limbs, or otherwise dangerously injured as a result of the outbreak. The victims included women, children and students. It is alleged that out of revenge for the assassination of the three officers whom the Jews had nicknamed "heroes of the anti-Jewish riots," the police turned the Black Hundreds loose armed with clubs and rubber sticks.
