At A Glance

WINNIPEG, May 20—(CP)—Rye futures prices rallied in late trading on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today, following a revival of the declining trend at Chicago and all options jumped the five cent limit at the close.

CHICAGO, May 20—(AP)—May rye soared 10 cents in the last 15 minutes of trading today, jumping from a low of \$2.22 3/8 to a high of \$2.32 3/8. At the high the contract was up the daily limit of five cents.

Favorable weather for crops brought some selling into corn and oats early, but part of the early downturn was regained.

MONTREAL, May 20—(CP)—Under the leadership of a number of key issues and influenced by New York, securities turned upward and average today on the stock exchange and curb market after the weak spell passed through last night's trading, tone was selectively strong at the bell. All pivotal groups moved up in the indices.

NEW YORK, May 20—(AP)—Steel, motors, rails and special issues traded early, but part of the early decline was regained. The Associated Press 60-stock average was up 5/8 of a point at 7:57 best come back since May 10.

TORONTO, May 20—(CP)—A sharp advance for Shell, Toronto and a wide break in Beaulieu, lowly stock stood out in today's trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange. The gold share price advanced 1/4 point in the index, the base metals gained 1/4 and the western oils finished the day unchanged in average.
