Stock Market Quiet Yesterday At New York
(By Victor Eubank, Associated Press Financial Writer)
NEW YORK, Dec. 11 (AP)—Selectivity ruled today's relatively quiet stock market with assorted favorites rising fractions to a point or more while many leaders showed losses of as much as 1/2.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was unchanged at 86.2. Canadian stocks were up fractionally. Hiram Walker led with a 5-8 gain. Distillers Stearns gained 1-4, McIntyre 1-2 and Dome Mines 3-8. On the curb, Lake Shore hardened 1-8.

American Woolen Preferred, a notably "thin" issue, was up 6 points at 172. Reports that the Cuban Government had agreed with sugar producers on prices lifted Francisco Sugar 1 5-8 at 25 5-8, West Indies Sugar 1 5-8 at 34 and Cuban-American Sugar 1 at 21. Schenley added 3 3-8 at 59 1-2. Gimmel 3 1-4 at 44. Engineers Public Service 3 1-4 at 32. American Can 2 at 98. American Times 3-8 at 168 3-8 and St Paul Preferred (on a pleasing dividend) 1 at 50. Du Pont was up 1 1-2 at 186 1-2. Allied Chemical 1 at 169 1-2 and Union Carbide 1 at 94.

Modern improvement was recorded for U.S. Steel, Bethlehem, General Motors, U.S. Rubber, Montgomery Ward, North American, Electric Power and Light, Kennecott, General Electric and Standard Oil (NJ).

U.S. Gypsum dropped 5 7-8 at 108 1-8. Chrysler 1 1-4 at 33 1-4. John-Manville 1 at 135 and Eastman Kodak 1 at 224. On the off-side also were Goodyear, Goodrich, International Harvester, Douglas Aircraft, Western Union, Western and Quebec, Santa Fe, Great Northern, Chesapeake and Ohio.
