FAIR PLAY FOR THE EAST IN IMMIGRATION.

In years past very frequent mention has been made in these columns of the fact that vast sums were annually spent by the federal government to fill the Northwest with immigrants...

Other speakers on the subject were Messrs. Bickerdike of Montreal, Carroll and Foster of Nova Scotia, Emmerson and Crockett of New Brunswick, McLean and Hughes of Prince Edward Island, Hon. Mr. Rogers, Minister of the Interior, and others...

"That, inasmuch as the immigration policy of the Government and the several railway companies has for many years been almost entirely confined to the development of Western Canada, and largely in consequence of this policy the Provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island have not grown in equal degree with the rest of the Dominion...

In the course of his speech on the subject Mr. Rhodes referred to the riches of the natural resources of the Maritime Provinces, where the population was almost wholly native born, our splendid ports, the nearest to Europe of any in Canada, and other conditions which should have invited immigration in large volume.

Hon. Mr. Rogers expressed his surprise at a remark of Mr. Emmerson that the Government's immigration representatives in London knew nothing about the Maritime Provinces. If that had been true in the past it would not be so in the future.

The speeches of the several speakers from the eastern section of the Dominion were optimistic as to the future of the East, if hereafter a policy of fair play shall be pursued in regard to immigration and general development.

OUTLINE OF THE HOME RULE BILL.

If the published outline of the Home Rule Bill is at all accurate the measure would seem to be pretty well guarded both as to the rights of the minority in Ireland and as to undue interference in matters of purely imperial concern.

There are further limitations in the constitution of the Irish Parliament. It is to have two Chambers, an appointed Legislative Council and an elected Legislative Assembly, the Council of about fifty members and the Assembly of one hundred and three members...
