OTTAWA, June 23.—In the senate today Senator Loughheed asked if it was true, as stated in a cable report, that the British ambassador at Washington, Sir Mortimer Durand, had agreed with the United States secretary, Mr. Root, as to the basis on which negotiations should be conducted for the settlement of fishery and other questions in dispute between Canada and the United States.

Hon. Mr. Scott said Ambassador Durand would make no arrangements for the settlement of disputes without the consent of Canada. Nothing had been done so far.


