New York Aug. 10. The meeting of King Edward and the German Emperor, now officially announced, will be hardly more than a stop over visit at Friedrichshof on the way to Marienbad. It comes when the complications of European diplomacy have passed, and there can be no suspicion of the weakening of the good relations between England and France. It cannot be a formal or unsympathetic meeting when it is ordered for the castle where the Empress Dowager Frederick died and were both sovereigns saw her for the last time. While they can be together only a few hours, the interval will be long enough for producing a moral effect throughout Europe. It will be a sign that England and Germany are on better terms than for a long period, and that the rivalries of commerce and diplomacy are not creating a feeling of resentment and unfriendliness.
