ECHOS OF CONVENTION.

The fruit growers seemed at length to be convinced of one thing: They must feed the trees to get good sized fruit, good colored fruit, good flavored fruit. This is the sort of fruit which fetches the money and after all it's the money we are after.

The splendid specimens of King's and other varieties put on the table by Geo. Auld, Covehead, were the main attraction. Mr. Auld takes first money in every class he enters. He must have specially well cared plantations. He was present at all the sessions, but evidently is a doer not a talker, for he never once addressed the chair.

Few men in all Canada are so thoroughly equipped in orcharding as our friend John Robertson, said Senator Ferguson. He propagates the trees, grows immense quantities of a large variety of fruits, packs in barrels and boxes made in his own mill, and sends jams and preserves to "nd." It really looks as if he knew what he was doing.

Alfred Dewar's exhibit of jams and honey was well worth examining. The bees did not do their best last year, we are told, but the product was good. The Exhibition jars of honey were presented to the President of the Association.

Mr. Belle Mutch was among the biggest prize-winners at the Fair. She was present herself throughout and most interested in the discussion. The question box detected the presence of other ladies. One query was: "Whose by light is the money from the orchard?" Senator Ferguson laughingly replied, "We'd better not decide that."

The question box was never so filled with queries covering the whole range of fruit growing, marketing, etc. This shows that many go to the P. G. A. meetings now for intimate information. It is what the Association would encourage too.

Cranberry growing, according to Expert Dickey, has had a couple of bad years, but it averages up well, and nobody would be discouraged, he avers.

John Robertson had several fine photos of different phases of his nursery on exhibition. Besides many plant boxes and barrels of apples he had also samples of what he styles "Apple Butter" and other preserved fruits at the Fair.

There was no trouble selling the prize fruit at big prices this year. The Fruit Fair will become a proper fruit market in short for choice sales.

The fruit grower wants a skilled horticulturist in the Government Farm; and certainly if any practical expert which is to be of any value to the province is contemplated, such a man is absolutely required. Professor Readey quite admitted the reasonableness of the request.

Hon. Mr. Reid is doing all he can for the fruit grower, and his work is appreciated.

Several business propositions were made to the fruit industry by outsiders through the President. One firm wanted to establish a curd factory if "roughage" could be purchased reasonably. Prof. Macoun and the most of the growers said the big wheel would pay best for the refuse apples fed him.


