PHILIPPINOS ATTACKED AMERICAN MINISTER.

MANILA, July 19.—Dean O. Worcester, American minister of the interior for the Philippines, was set upon by renegade Moros on the island of Palawan today and escaped assassination only through the alertness of his bodyguard who shot down the outlaws, killing three of them outright. Secretary of Interior Worcester was touring the island, which is the most westerly of the large islands of the Philippine group, heading the Sulu Sea on the west and was present at the installation of the new governor. In anticipation of his coming a band of Moros planned his death. Armed with bolos carefully concealed they laid a trap for the secretary who suddenly found himself the object of a savage rush.

NEW BRUNSWICKER MISSING SUPPOSED TO BE MURDERED.

SALISBURY, July 19.—Judson Foster, Parish Court Commissioner, of Salisbury, fears that his brother Harry, who is missing, has been foully murdered near Winnipeg. The missing man was a bachelor. He had saved considerable money, and disposed of his holdings in Winnipeg, early in May, with the intention of coming to Salisbury and spending his declining years here with his brother. All trace of him has been lost.

BATHED ONCE YEARLY.

WASHINGTON, July 18.—To take a bath but once a year and to provide a single apple pie and five cents' worth of crackers for one's bride on the night of her wedding, with other testimony, furnished grounds for a limited divorce, granted by Justice Anderson in the District Supreme Court.

Henrietta Newman sued Meyer B. Newman, who is considered wealthy. She will get \$60 a month alimony until January next, and after that \$70 a month, with \$400 counsel fees. Mrs. Newman testified that her husband at the time of their marriage, nearly two years ago, took her to a cold house and set before her pie and crackers for her wedding supper. She swore that she never had enough to eat, and that her husband's aversion to a bath-tub made it impossible for her to remain with him.

NEW YORK PIER IS BURNED; MEN MISSING.

NEW YORK, July 18.—Three of the crew of the H. F. Dimock, a Metropolitan line freighter which caught fire during a blaze which destroyed Pier 14 yesterday, were still unaccounted for today. Officers of the Metropolitan line fear that they were drowned.

HANS WAGNER'S DAY OF USEFULNESS PASSED?

PITTSBURG, July 18.—An evening paper states that Hans Wagner, once worshipped by all fandom as its foremost idol, is dissatisfied with his berth as a member of the Pirates and has created dissension in the ranks of the team. It charges the miserable showing of the champions to this cause and says: "Although Wagner draws a salary of \$10,000 a year, as a player under contract is supposed to play as directed by the manager of the team, it is a secret that time and again Honus has disobeyed instructions."

GIRL THIEVES AUDACIOUS.

NEW YORK, July 18.—Amsterdam avenue storekeepers near Eightieth street have been complaining of being victimized by two very small but very audacious girl thieves. The girls are apparently only about 12 years old, and even then they are so stunted that their heads hardly can be seen above the counter of the average store.

One of the girls has chestnut colored hair and wears a blue polka dot dress. The other has black hair and wears a plaidingham dress. Both have hard voices and their accent can only be described as "unusually tough."
