HON GEORGE E. FOSTER.

As the newspaper discussion of the Conservative leadership goes on it develops a greater weight of opinion in favor of Hon. George E. Foster than for any other man. It seems probable that in the end he will be the party choice. The selection is of importance to the entire country inasmuch as the choice of a leader for the Opposition may ultimately make the man who is chosen the Premier of Canada.

Winnipeg is a progressive city in many ways and has gone into debt in a fashion that would make prudent eastern people shiver. According to the Free Press of that city the total debt is \$5,347,888 made up as follows: General debenture debt \$3,001,538; local improvement debenture debt, \$1,220,742; over draft at the bank, \$525,588.

"Can we telephone to the mainland?" was a question asked by one of the leading men attending the recent meeting of the Stock-breeders' Association. Of course everyone here knows that there is no telephone connection across the Straits, and also that it would be a very convenient thing to have at all times, especially during the twelve hours of the day and night during which the Anglo-American wires are resting and rusting.

It is interesting to note that Canadian farmers received two million dollars more from the sale of cheese during the year ended with October last than in any previous year. The sales made a total of \$17,000,000, all the cheese being sold in Great Britain. At the same time our export of butter fell off nearly 50 per cent. from the previous year, for reasons not fully explained, but partly due to the high price of cheese.

The Toronto Globe in answer to a correspondent concludes that the prohibition vote was not the cause of the ill-success of the Liberals in Ontario at the late election. Mr. McMullen was one of the more prominent Liberals who were defeated though he had for many years consistently supported prohibition in and out of Parliament.
