### LARGE REAL ESTATE DEAL IN SANDWICH, ONTARIO.

Announcement has been made of a large and important real estate deal in Sandwich by which the Home Bank has purchased for \$10,700.00 large Robinet block in the county town, located at the corner of Mill and Bedford streets, from Jules Robinet.

The block is about fifty-two feet square in dimension and contains the store of Arthur Page, the Acme Hardware Company store under the management of A. R. Marette, and the Robinet Wine Company on the first floor, a dwelling flat on the C. M. B. A. Hall on the second, and an assembly hall of considerable size on the third floor.

It is the intention of the Home Bank to vacate their present premises in the McKee block on Bedford Street West and locate in the corner store of Mr. Page. The corner will be completely remodelled to make a modern Bank. Mr. Page has been given notice to vacate on January 31st.

The transaction is evidence of the confidence the management of the Home Bank has in the predicted future rapid increase of Sandwich. Since establishment in March of 1908 the business done by the Bank, under the management of P. F. Lovegrove, has been steadily on the increase, it being patronised by many commercial and financial institutions in this vicinity.

(The P. F. Lovegrove mentioned in the above was formerly a member of the Bank of New Brunswick staff of this city, and his many friends, both here and elsewhere, will be pleased to learn of his continued success in banking circles in Ontario.)
