### THE EDITOR'S MAIL.

Saloons With Blinds Down.

Sir,—I wish through you to ask who it is that has the charge of enforcing the law in regard to our present liquor licenses. I understand the law to be that all blinds must be raised high enough, and all obstructions removed so as to leave the inside of the room in which liquors are sold, open to the full open view of everybody passing by.

New let me call your attention to one of the largest Hotels in this city. Walk down Great George Street; the large window there with the blind down to the sill. Then go in the front on the other street, and you find the blind down to the neck of the bottles. Look at the door with its glass panels and the blind down within a little of the bottom. These are so day and night. To see in you have to go to the front, bend down and peep under the blinds, but in the other window you cannot even do that. But the front window has the bottles in plain view to tempt and entice people in. This state of affairs has to my certain knowledge existed for the last three months.

I now call upon our Attorney-General to rise and explain why this is allowed and whose duty it is to enforce this law, and let the breaker of the law be brought up immediately and fined, for what is a fact to-day, and then again promptly for every day this state of things exists. Are there no officers to enforce this law, or must we employ a Mrs. Nation with her hatchet?

LONDON, March 14.—The Times asserts that the government's proposals for the civil list show a total of £470,000, being £110,000 for His Majesty's privy purse and the rest for the expenses of the Royal household. The Queen Consort's allowance is £50,000 and is included in the total already given. This will be increased to £70,000 in the event of the death of the King.

### A CONSCIENTIOUS PASTOR.

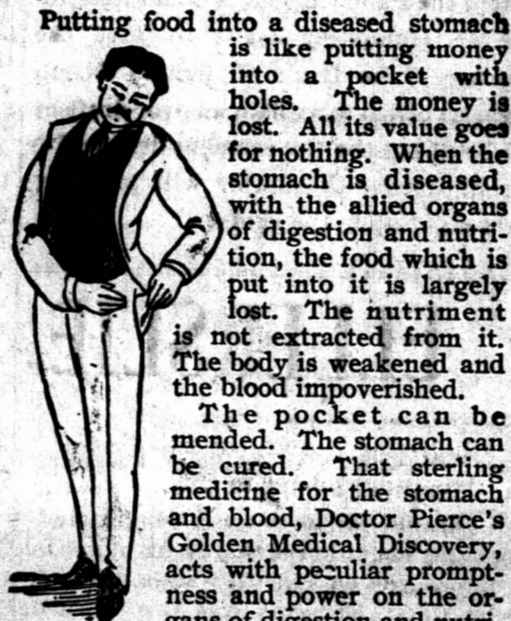
NEW YORK, March 14.—A special to the World from Denver announces that the Rev. Robert F. Coyle, the new pastor of the Central Presbyterian church submitted his resignation yesterday morning at the close of his sermon. He told his congregation that he declined to be placed in the position of countenancing the iniquities of fashionable life, while he found that the laboring men and women did not go to church because many of his church members were cold to the thought of drawing in this class of people and drew aside their skirts from any such contact. In leaving Denver Dr. Coyle gave up a salary of \$5,000.

### THE SUBMARINE BOATS FOR THE BRITISH ARMY.

LONDON, March 15.—Now that the British government has admitted that it is building submarine boats the Vickers Company has given out their corrected dimensions and other particulars. They will be sixty-three feet four inches long, have eleven feet nine inches beam and have a submerged displacement of 120 tons.

LONDON, March 18.—The Tien Tain correspondent of the Standard, says: "The railway dispute here is another of the attempts of the Russian admiral Alexieff to create trouble and unless he is removed there will be constant friction which will eventually lead to hostilities. He loses no opportunity to thwart the English."
