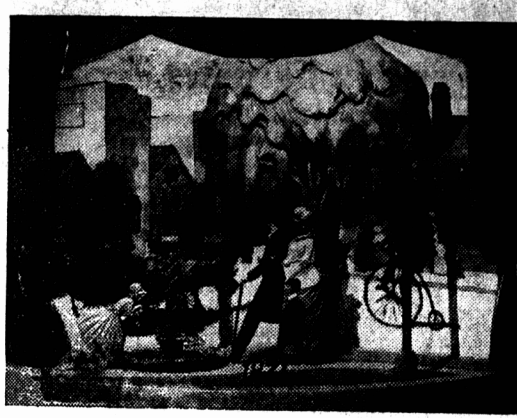
FOOD MANUFACTURE

An interesting display being shown across Canada in conjunction with the 75th Anniversary of Confederation Life Association is now in the windows of Holman's Ltd.

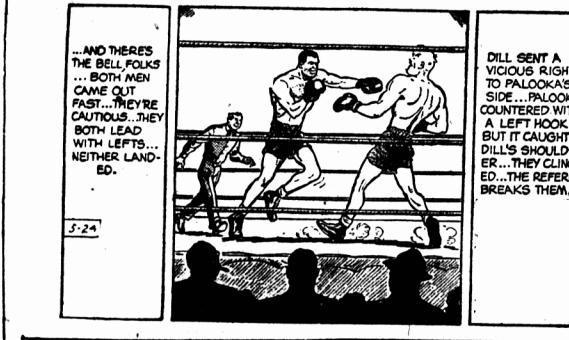

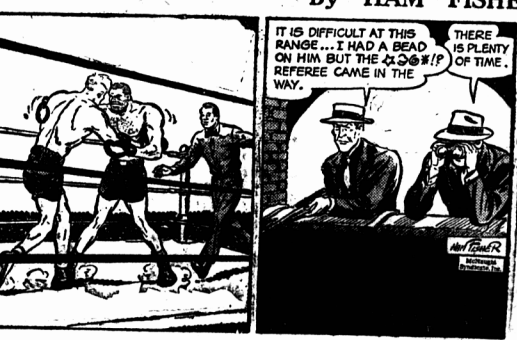

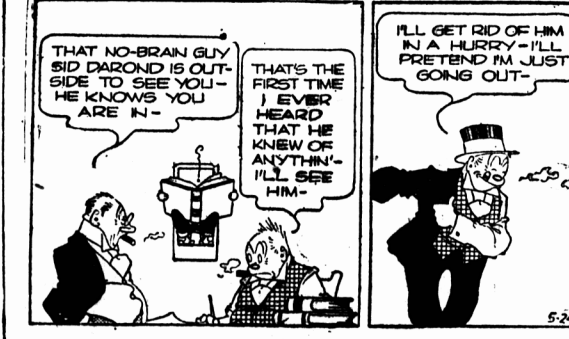
