British Government To Boost Shipping

LONDON (CP Cable)—The British Government plans a large-scale drive to add to the nation's shipping—both naval and merchant.

Control of all shipbuilding will be placed under the Admiralty as in the first Great War and every inch of space in yards scattered along the coasts of the United Kingdom will be pressed into service.

David Lloyd George, Britain's national leader in the last war and a big-time farmer of Churt, Surrey, urged construction of every scrap of land in the country and
