## PRINCE COUNTY COURT HOUSE HAS BEEN REBUILT

Many Improvements Made in the New Building—a Splendid Edifice—Expected That It Will be Ready by the End of Year.

The destruction of the Prince County Court House and Jail, by fire of October 10-11, 1906, made a temporary change in the location of the Court, the Prothonotary's, Registry and Sheriff's offices and Jail, at least for the space of fourteen months.

One who watched the burning of this structure on the morning of October 11th, one year passed could hardly realize that the brick shell and stone trimmings would be preserved in such good condition, and would again be filled in with timber and lumber to replace that which was burned. The contract was let to D. R. Morrison, and P. J. Clark, who started to clear away the debris and rebuild in July last, and by Christmas the entire building will be ready for its old occupants.

In the basement the whole floor is being concreted and the walls plastered with Portland cement plaster. The fuel will be placed in two of the cells, instead of in an outside building, and a new steam heating apparatus will replace the old one. The cells are the same as before, except for repairs. The building will be lighted by electricity.

On the first flat the above named offices will be situated as before. In the Prothonotary's office a large vault has been built. In the registry office the vault is being repainted and other repairs made.

At the entrance of the hall a brick porch has been added, bearing a tablet of stone with the date 1907. On the left of the entrance a toilet room has been built.

On the second flat, at one end of the hall leading to the Court room is a new, bright roomy, spare office. The ceiling of the Court room is being covered with steel sheeting, which when painted will be much more pleasing to the eye than the dingy old ceiling of days gone by.

The Court room will be laid off practically the same as before, and the Judges' chambers and barristers and jury rooms have been retouched to improve on pre-existing conditions.

The home of the janitor and jailer will be above, as before, and a large storage room is on the top floor.

The roof, covered with slate, is strongly mounted at the top, and bears a cupola, called an observatory, from which one can obtain a most satisfactory view of the town of Summerside, the harbor, and the surrounding country. It has been whispered that the building will never stand the pressure of a gale, but to dispel such fears it may be useful to note that the writer while up in the observatory with the most storm of the season felt altogether at ease and there was not the slightest tremor of the brick walls or the lofty roof, which is braced together with substantial rods and trusses.

All modern improvements have been added throughout the building, which when completed and the scaffolding removed will be one of the most attractive looking edifices in the Province.

The Court House and jail was originally built in Summerside, and was first occupied in the year 1874; before which time the first and only building of its kind was that at St. Eleanor's.
