Markets At A Glance

MONTREAL, Oct 23—Prices of all classes with the exception of potatoes advanced on the Montreal dairy and produce market today. The butter market became 19 to 19 1/2 cents a pound for carlots or less of no 1 butter up 1/4 to 1/2 cents from last week's closing level. Arrivals amounted to 230 boxes. Eggs continued the advance started early last week as supplies became still scarcer with the advancing season. Graded shipments in carlots or less became 34 to 35 cents a dozen for extras, 28 to 29 cents for firsts and 17 to 17 1/2 cents for seconds. Receipts for the day totalled only 120 cases as against 224 for the same day last week and 388 for the same day last year. The market was one to two cents higher than last week's close on extras and firsts and 1/2 cent lower on seconds. Ontario cheese was generally quoted...

LIVESTOCK

MONTREAL, Oct 23—Offerings on the two Montreal livestock markets today totalled 15,000. Cattle receipts were 1884. There were not enough early sales of cattle to establish prices.

Calf receipts were 2,878. Good calves were steady at \$6 to \$6.50 for grassers with an odd calf selling as early as \$7. Medium veals were \$5.25 to \$5.75 and drinkers and common veals from \$2.75 to \$4.50. Fully grassers. These were 25 cents lower and were sold from \$1.50 to \$2.25, with the bulk between \$2 and \$2.10. Good and choice veal \$3 to \$3.50; common and medium, \$2.75 to \$3.75; grassers \$1.50 to \$2.25.

Sheep receipts were 5,074. A couple of loads of lambs were delivered on former contract at \$3.50 with culls and bucks out at \$3.85. Fresh sales were made at \$5.75 for good ewes and wethers with culls and bucks out. A couple of small lots of straight buck lambs brought \$4.50 and \$4.75. Sheep were sold for \$1 to \$2.75 according to quality.
