Tornado Sweeps Over Texas

DALLAS, Texas, May 11.—Four persons were reported killed, five seriously injured and many others slightly hurt in a wind, rain, and hail storm of tornado proportions that swept across the south western part of Lamar County and into Delta county in Northern Texas today. All those reported dead are negroes, two women and two children, said to have been killed at Noble in the southern part of Lamar County. The storm swept a path from five to seven miles wide and about 30 miles long. Great damage was done to buildings and crops.

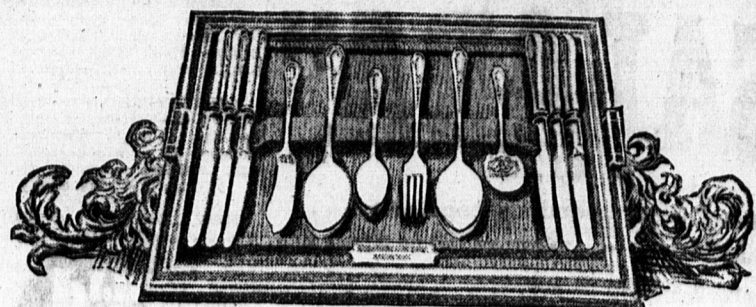

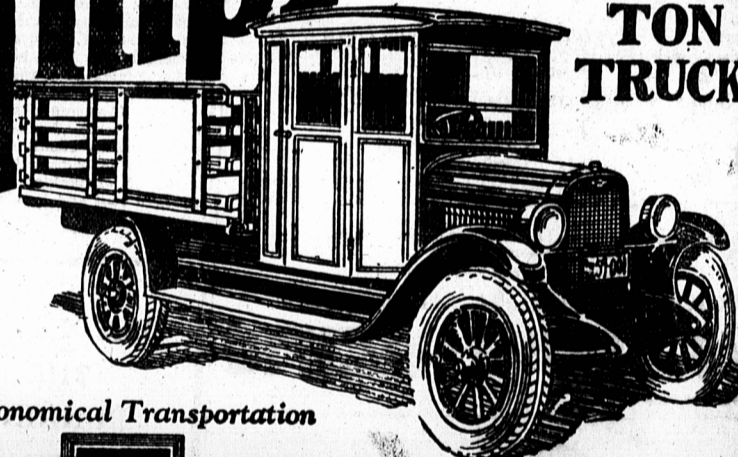
