### CRUISERS FOR CANADA.

OTTAWA, November 6.—The Government of Canada is completing arrangements with the British Admiralty for a loan of two cruisers. This will be the first step towards the formation of the proposed Canadian Navy. Their primary purpose is to serve as training ships. They will be used in conjunction with a Navy School which will be immediately established. One of the Cruisers will be on the Atlantic and the other will be on the Pacific coast. The vessels will also be used as fishery protection cruisers.

### HONDURAS HELPING ZELAYA.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 6.—President Taft's rancors are reaching the State Department to the effect that the Government of Honduras is giving active support to President Zelaya in Nicaragua in his contest against the insurrectionary army of General Estrada. The seizure by Honduras officials of the American launch, the property of the Laguarda De Paris Fruit Company, concerning which complaint has been made to the United States legation in Honduras will be made the subject of a protest by this Government. Beyond this it is not the present purpose of the State Department to take any action with respect to the attitude of Honduras toward the Zelaya Government. Developments, however, are being watched with the keenest interest.

### RADIUM \$2,500,000 AN OUNCE.

LONDON, Nov. 6.—Once it was possible to buy radium at \$2 a milligramme; now the market price is \$90 a milligramme, equal to \$2,500,000 an ounce.

This was one of the striking statements in a very interesting speech delivered by Sir William Ramsay at the foundation stone laying ceremony last Saturday of a new radium factory in Limehouse, an eastern suburb of London. The British Radium Corporation, which is going to extract radium from pitchblende found in the Trenwith mine, Cornwall, is believed to be the first company in the world to attempt the production of the precious mineral on a commercial basis.

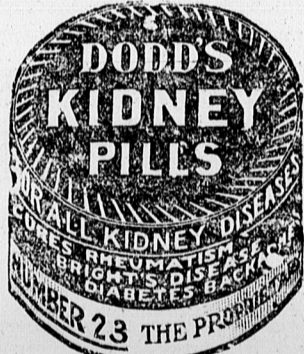

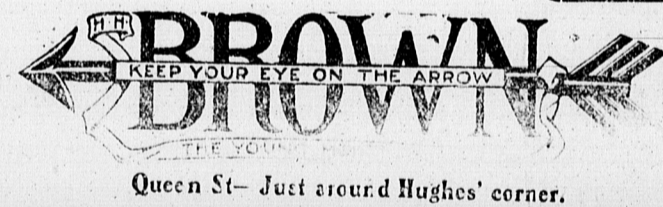

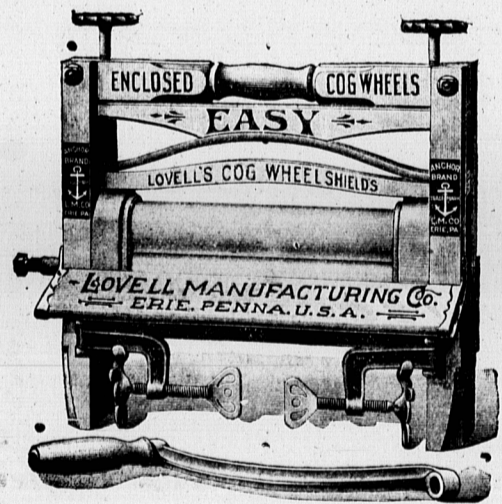
