Influenced by the improved tone of New York and London, interested leaders firmed moderately. Imperial Oil and B. A. Oil added fractions, smelters-seagams and Walkers common added 1-4-1-2 and Ford A climbed 1-4.

Home Oil climbed 10 cents. Calgary-Edmonton, Anglo-Canadian and Oklaia firmed 2 to 3 cents and Royalite closed unchanged. McIntyre firmed 1-4 and other senior golds held firm. Wright-Hargreaves traded quite actively on a gain of 5 cents and Teck-Hughes firmed the same amount. Other issues adding 4 to 10 cents were Lamaque, Macassa, Preston, Little Long Lac, Perron and Powell. Shares of Auror gold mines were listed today and traded actively opening at 1.85 and closing at 1.75. Auror has absorbed the Augite property and one share of Auror represents three of Augite, now delisted. Augite closed yesterday at 61.

The close was up a point for Noranda and 1-4 for Nickel. Gains of 15 cents were netted by Waiate-Amulet and Ventures, a body and cheaper base metals were a bit soft.

MONTREAL, June 2 (CP)—

Pound Sterling, the United States dollar and French francs closed unchanged on Montreal foreign exchange today. The pound was quoted at 4 59-1-4, held near 4 1-1-4, 60 3-16 and the franc at 2 65-1-2. NEW YORK, June 2 (AP)—The Swiss franc joined the Netherlands guilder as the liveliest of overseas monies in foreign exchange dealings today. The guilder—beset by effects of internal political difficulties and transfer of funds from Holland to Switzerland, bankers said—declined 11 of a cent in terms of the dollar. The Swiss franc, on the other hand, gained 04 of a cent, helped in part by the shift of money out of Amsterdam. Sterling added 1-15 of a cent to 4.58 3-8 but the French franc at 2 65 and the belga were unchanged. The Canadian dollar improved 3-64 to a discount of 11-64.
