THE PLOT AGAINST LEADER BORDEN

The Ottawa Journal, Conservative, past, makes a seemingly candid statement as to the movement to induce Mr. Borden to resign the leadership of the Opposition and how it failed.

The Journal affirms that the most serious opposition to Mr. Borden comes from the Province of Quebec and names Rudolph Forget, M. P., and William Price, M. P., two of the richest men in Canada, and Rufus H. Pope, another prominent Conservative and former member of Parliament.

There is matter to interest almost everybody in the plan to reform the calendar as proposed by the Government of Switzerland, and which is to form the subject of an international congress. It is in the direction of simplification, and is one of those reforms which it is claimed if once adopted would soon stand as high in favor as the decimal system in our currency.

By this plan the year, the month and the week would conform to a regular system. The week would begin as now with Sunday and end with Saturday and so would the month and the year.

Ottawa despatches to some Opposition papers intimate that the session of Parliament is likely to be prolonged till midsummer. As such would not accord with the wishes of the Government, it may be inferred that it is the intention of the Opposition to delay the granting of supply, or perhaps in the end to block some necessary portion thereof in order to force a dissolution.

On the other hand there have been several public intimations given to the effect that the Government may appeal to the country very shortly after the trade agreement is ratified by Parliament. Hon. Mr. Paterson gave such an intimation shortly after his return from Washington.

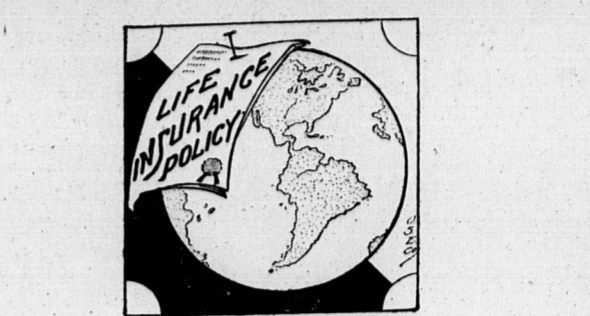
