Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years of age, may home settle a quarter-section of available Dominion and in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The application must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency on certain conditions, by father, brother, son, daughter, brother or sister of attending homesteader.

Duties. Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres when owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section adjacent to his homestead. Price \$2.00 per acre. Duties. Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry, including the time required to earn homestead patent and cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$500.00.
