(C.P. By Guardian's Special Wire) WINNIPEG, May 19—Winnipeg broilers, lacking any cue from Livestock Council, closely watched Chicago trend and at the end of erratic trading today wheat futures were 1-8 lower to 1-2 cents higher, May at \$1.14 1-8, July \$1.02 1-2 and October 84 3-8 cents. Gains of almost a cent were recorded at the start when dispatches from the southwest winter wheat belt told of torrential rains in sections accompanied by high winds that loughed wheat over a wide area, notably in Kansas. Cash wheat dealings were jaded and spreads for top grades of Red Springs closed unchanged. Durum eased slightly. May and July oats climbed more than a cent on short-covering and investment demand but other coarse grain futures showed little change. Fine quotations were 1-8-1-5 higher, flax 1-4 lower to unchanged and rye 1-4 higher to 5-8 lower.
