\$200,000,000 LOAN PLEDGED GREECE

WASHINGTON, Oct. 14, (Special)—A loan of \$200,000,000 has been pledged to representatives of Greece in Paris, London and Washington. Fifty million dollars in bonds is to be taken up by the New York money market and the remainder for the most part, will go to Paris. The money will be used for the development of the territory taken from Turkey in the Balkan War, such as the establishment of schools, hospitals, roads, railroads and post offices. Also a portion of the loan will go into the construction of a navy. Mr. Valeriotis, president of the National Bank of Greece, is now in Paris concluding negotiations with the French bankers. Word has been received in Washington from him that the amount of \$150,000,000 had already been promised in France just as soon as the Turkish-Grecian treaty has been signed, and as soon as the Powers have disposed of the islands of Mitylene, Rhodes and Chios, to which Turkey lays claim. In his letter to the Grecian representative in Washington who is conducting negotiations with the New York bankers Mr. Valeriotis said that as Turkey has ordered an envoy to Athens equipped with extraordinary powers to negotiate a treaty and as a commission had been appointed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs at Athens to meet him, he expected the treaty to be concluded within a few weeks.

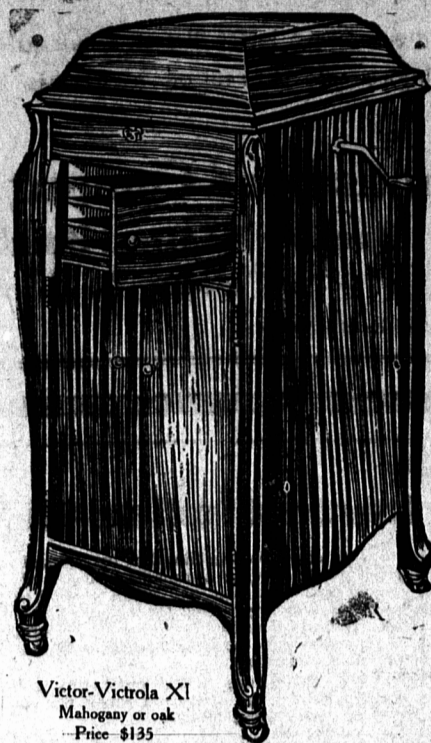

WOMENS GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP UP

WILMINGTON, DEL., Oct. 13.—The eyes of all women who are interested not merely in golf, but in any form of outdoor athletics for women will be turned during the present week upon the Ladies of the Wilmington Country Club, where the competition for the women's golf championship was opened today. Added interest is given the tournament this year by the participation of two of the most noted women golfers of Great Britain. They are Miss Muriel Dodd, the present British title holder, and Miss Mabel Harrison, three times winner of the Irish championship. The championship tournament was begun today with an 18-hole medal play, qualifying round, the best 32 becoming eligible for match play. Tomorrow the first match round will be run off with a consolation event for those who fail to reach the desired goal. Besides the second round on Wednesday there will be an 18-hole match play handicap against bogey, while on Thursday, in addition to the third match play round, driving, approaching and putting contests will be held. Coincident with the semi-final round on Friday there will be a foursome competition on scratch basis, while mixed foursomes will be run off in conjunction with the decisive test on Saturday.

MASONIC TEMPLE FOR CALIFORNIA

SAN FRANCISCO, CAL., Oct. 13.—High degree Masons from every section of the State gathered in this city today to participate in the exercises at the formal dedication of the Masonic Temple of California, which was recently completed at a cost of several hundred thousand dollars. The visitors also will take part in the annual Grand Lodge meeting of the order, which is to begin its session in the new temple tomorrow morning.

RECOGNITION AND INDUCTIO OF REV. J. W. HAMILTON AT LINDEN.

The following reference will be of interest to many in Prince Edward Island, as Mr. Hamilton is a native of this Province. On Wednesday afternoon and evening of Oct. 1st a council composed of ministers and delegates from the Baptist churches in Cumberland county met at Linden for the purpose of examining and passing upon the credentials recommendations and etc., of Rev. J. W. Hamilton, the pastor elect of the churches on the Linden-Tidnish field, says an Oxford exchange. The council organized by appointing Rev. J. B. Woodland chairman, and Deacon M. Johnson of Oxford secretary. Mr. Hamilton, who came to the Baptist denomination from the church known as the Disciples of Christ, submitted the council his ordination papers and testimonials to his good standing, character and work in connection with the Disciple church. The council after due consideration, voted unanimously to accept his ordination at the hands of a sister church and expressed themselves as entirely satisfied with the credentials and other papers submitted by Mr. Hamilton. In the evening a public service was held in the Baptist church which was well filled with an intelligent and appreciative audience. Rev. J. B. Woodland presided. The first order of procedure was a sermon preached by Rev. P. J. Stackhouse pastor of the Baptist church at Amherst from the text 2nd Cor. 5-19. The audience was treated to a discourse of unusual ability and power in Mr. Stackhouse's well known lucid and eloquent style. Then followed the reception into the membership of the Linden Baptist church of Rev. Mr. Hamilton, his wife and daughter. The church had asked Rev. J. T. Dimock a former pastor to give the hand of fellowship to the new members which he did in a very appropriate and feeling address. Having been made members of the church the presiding officer Rev. J. B. Woodland made an official declaration to the public of the acceptance of Rev. Mr. Hamilton into the regularly constituted ministry of the Baptist denomination and with the hand of recognition and fellowship welcomed him into ranks of the Baptist ministry. The charge to the church and congregation was given by Rev. J. W. Smith, pastor of the Baptist church at Greenville which he did in a very admirable and practical manner. The proceedings closed with the benediction by the new pastor, Rev. Mr. Hamilton. The delegates from Oxford were Dea. M. Johnson, J. S. Hickman and Wesley Black, Deacon Isaac Patten represented the Leicestershire church. Mr. Hamilton enters upon his labors on the Linden field under very encouraging circumstances, and the sentiment of the entire district is that of genuine and hearty appreciation.
