"Drink?"

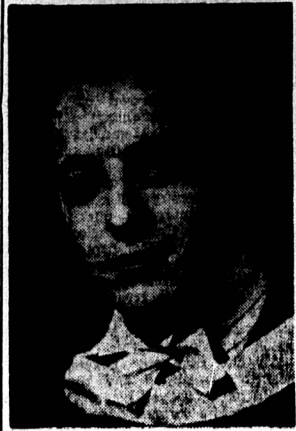
