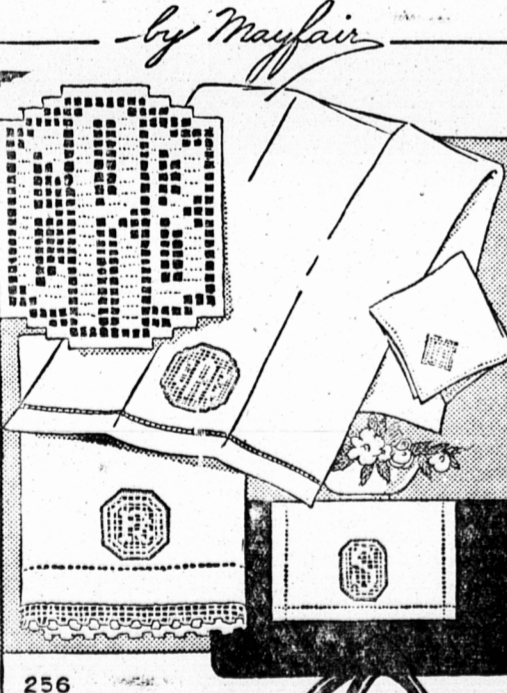
INTRODUCING COLOR INTO MODERN HOME

THE COOK'S CORNER

FRESH COCOANUT CAKE

- 1-2 cup butter
1 cup sugar
4 egg yolks
2 cups cake flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1-8 teaspoon salt
1 cup cocoanut milk
4 egg whites
Method: Cream the butter and add the sugar gradually, continuing to cream until the mixture is very light and fluffy. Add the well beaten egg yolks and beat the batter hard.

BANANA MILK FLUFF

Have two-thirds of a cup of mashed banana; three tablespoons orange juice; three tablespoons of honey or syrup; half a teaspoon almond extract; a few grains of salt; two cups of milk. Mix all well together with an egg beater.

STRAWBERRY MILK SHAKE

Have one-third a cup of hulled sugar and flour mixture, a tablespoon at a time, beating hard after each addition.

BOILED ICING

- 1 1-2 cups granulated sugar
1 tablespoon corn arvup
3-4 cup boiling water
2 egg whites, beaten stiff
1 teaspoon vanilla
Grated fresh cocoanut
Method: M'x the sugar, corn arvup and water and cook over a low heat until the sugar is dissolved and the mixture boils. Then cook steadily without stirring until a few drops spin a long thread from the tip of the spoon. Pour in a fine stream over the stiffly beaten egg whites, beating constantly until the icing is thick enough to spread. Add the flavoring and spread between the layers and over the sides and top of the cake. Sprinkle thickly with the cocoanut while the icing is still moist.

FRESH COCOANUT MACAROONS

- 5 tablespoons granulated sugar
5 tablespoons icing sugar
1 tablespoon flour
2 egg whites
1-4 teaspoon vanilla
1 cup grated fresh cocoanut
Method: Sift the flour and sugar together. Beat the egg whites until they are foamy, then add the
