A BIG DAY IN POLICE COURT

Inspector Jenkins' Scores Distinct Triumph.

Two Old Offenders Sent Down to Jail For Six Months Each—Another Case Pending and Two First Offences.

Saturday was a big day for the Temperance people in the Police Court and probably never since Inspector Jenkins began his battle with the liquor forces has he met with such success.

The magistrate ruled that a prima facie case had been made out which must be rebutted.

The Magistrate in giving judgment said that Chappell's evidence had not been rebutted. He did not believe one word of Horne from beginning to end.

The Gillis adjourned case for third offence then came up. Inspector Jenkins having closed the case Mr. Weeks said he appeared for Gillis.

The case was adjourned on Mr. Weeks' request for a week and he stated that he would do his best to have Chappell present for cross-examination.

George Shepherd, keeper of the old Rankin House on the evidence of Daniel McLaren was fined \$100 or 3 months imprisonment.

John McDonald, Grafton Street was also fined \$100 or 3 months for violation of the Prohibition Act.

Two drunks, John McDonald and Kenneth McLeod were fined \$4 or 15 days each.

At the afternoon session the case of Mrs. Annie Coyle for keeping a disorderly house came up for hearing.

The two most important witnesses, sailors named Thistle and O'Brien were missing and it is alleged they left the province Saturday morning.

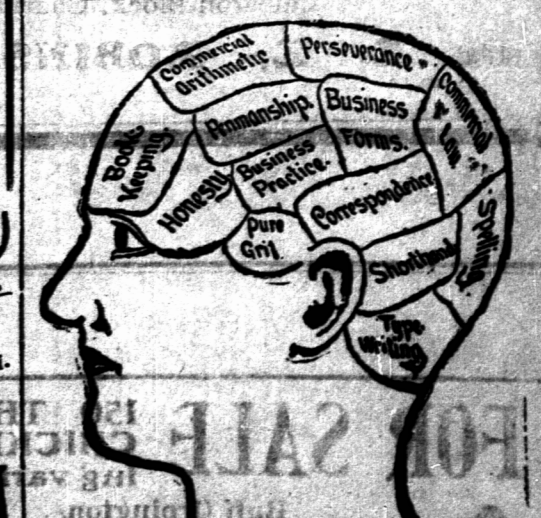
