British Civil Aviation Minister To Retain Job

LONDON, Nov. 25 (AP)—Prime Minister Attlee called his Civil Aviation Minister on the carpet today for the second time in 18 hours and then decided not to dismiss him. The Minister, 43-year-old Lord Pakenham, has been under heavy fire for criticizing an inquiry report on the crash of a Royal Dutch (KLM) Airlines craft in Britain, killing 40 persons.

Lord Pakenham rejected part of the non-partisan report, which blamed the Ministry's weather staff at Prestwick Airport, Scotland, for failing to warn the pilot about lowering ceilings as the plane approached the field.

The Minister was called in Thursday night for a 50-minute talk with Attlee and left snapping "not a word" at inquiring reporters. He was there again today for an hour conferring with Attlee and several senior ministers. He left smiling broadly and unofficial word filtered from the Prime Minister's office that Lord Pakenham's resignation was not requested.

It was reported that the conference in the Prime Minister's office considered methods of defending the civil air chief's behavior in Parliament where Opposition leaders' both Houses have angrily demanded a public airing.

It was understood Lord Pakenham will be required to explain to Parliament why he rejected the inquiry report. Lord Pakenham released the court of inquiry's report together with a statement of his own which held that other factors, including the Dutch pilot's use of improper charts, were responsible for the crash.

The plane, a transatlantic airliner, was attempting a night landing at Prestwick Airport Oct. 20, 1948, when it crashed into high tension cables and burned. All 40 persons aboard were killed.

Under Civil Air Ministry regulations independent courts of inquiry are appointed to investigate such accidents, fix responsibility, and recommend steps for preventing recurrences.
