Some Pertinent Facts of Civic Contest.

HOW THE PEOPLE VOTED

In the Face of Two Tickets Who Were Used Strongly in the Canvass.

In the civic election which took place on Tuesday last like many previous contests there were interesting features which when "crystallized" show how strangely and independently people will cast their ballots.

There were 553 citizens voted of whom 22 were women, and 12 ballots were spoiled. Out of the 541 good ballots cast for from one to six of the twelve candidates, there were 170 different ballots.

There were 179 who voted for the straight People's Progressive Ticket, while 121 voters stood by the straight Citizens Reform Ticket. There were 44 who voted for five of the Progressive ticket and one of the Reform ticket, while 3 voted for five only of the Progressive ticket.

For the Reformers there were 33 voters who balloted for five with one progressive, 28 voted for four reformers and two progressives, 4 voted for four reformers and one progressive, 5 voted for five reformers only, 11 voted for four reformers only, three voted for 3 reformers and 2 progressives, three voted for 3 reformers and 1 progressive, one voted for 3 reformers only, and there were 42 who voted for three of each ticket.

There were 491 who voted for six councillors; 29 voted for five councillors; 13 voted for four councillors; 3 voted for three councillors; and 5 voted for one councillor only.

Voting for the Progressive ticket four electors dropped Dickleson and substituted Clark; two exchanged him for Muttart; two preferred Milligan; while two voted for the other five only. Five dropped Bowness and substituted Clark; three dropped him and substituted Johnston; three substituted Muttart; two substituted Brown; and two dropped him and voted for the other five only.

Voting for the reformers' ticket, four dropped Milligan and included Morris; four dropped him and took up Morrison; eight dropped him, voted for Dickleson; he was dropped by three who substituted Compton; two substituted Sobey; and two voted for the other five only. Two dropped Currie for Morris. There were others who dropped two or three of the one side for two or three of the opposing candidates.
