ORDER HAS BEEN COUNTERMANDED

Italian Fleet Will Not Visit Turkish Waters As Turkey Has Given Assurances In Regard To Postal Matters In Dispute

LONDON, April 20—(Special)—A despatch received here from Rome says orders have been issued countermanding the sending of an Italian squadron to Turkish waters for the purpose of coercing the Sultan into granting Italy certain postal privileges in Turkish territory.
