### TREATIES AND CONTRACTS

Treaties are among nations much what contracts are among citizens—solemn undertakings to the performance or observance of which national honor is pledged, just as the individual pledges his honor and his estate to the fulfilling of his obligations. When the individual makes default or violates his undertakings a kind of force is had recourse to, and often in the end actual, physical force is applied. The citizen failing to carry out his obligations is sued in the courts, and if he does not comply with the judgment rendered against him, the officers of the courts have recourse to force in order to carry out the court's decision. As has been said by a great jurist, litigation is to individuals what war is to nations. The individual in fault can be called before the courts of his country, but there is no international tribunal with sufficient force behind it to call to account a nation violating its treaties, and the nations aggrieved have to take the case into their own hands and apply force by means of war.

Germany Has About Nine Times the Population of Belgium

Belgium has an area of 11,373 square miles, approximately equal to that of the State of Maryland, or to that of Western New York, east of Syracuse. Her population, 7,432,784, is approximately equal to that of the State of Pennsylvania.

Compared to this, the German Empire in Europe has an area of 208,789 square miles, or approximately that of the States of New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Michigan. The population of Germany is 64,921,993, or nearly three-fourths that of the entire United States.

The war strength of Belgium's army is 222,000, while that of Germany is 6,200,000.

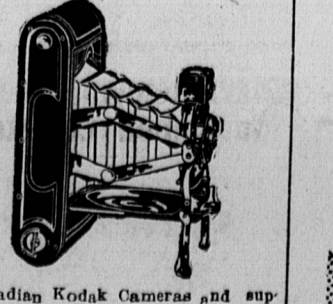

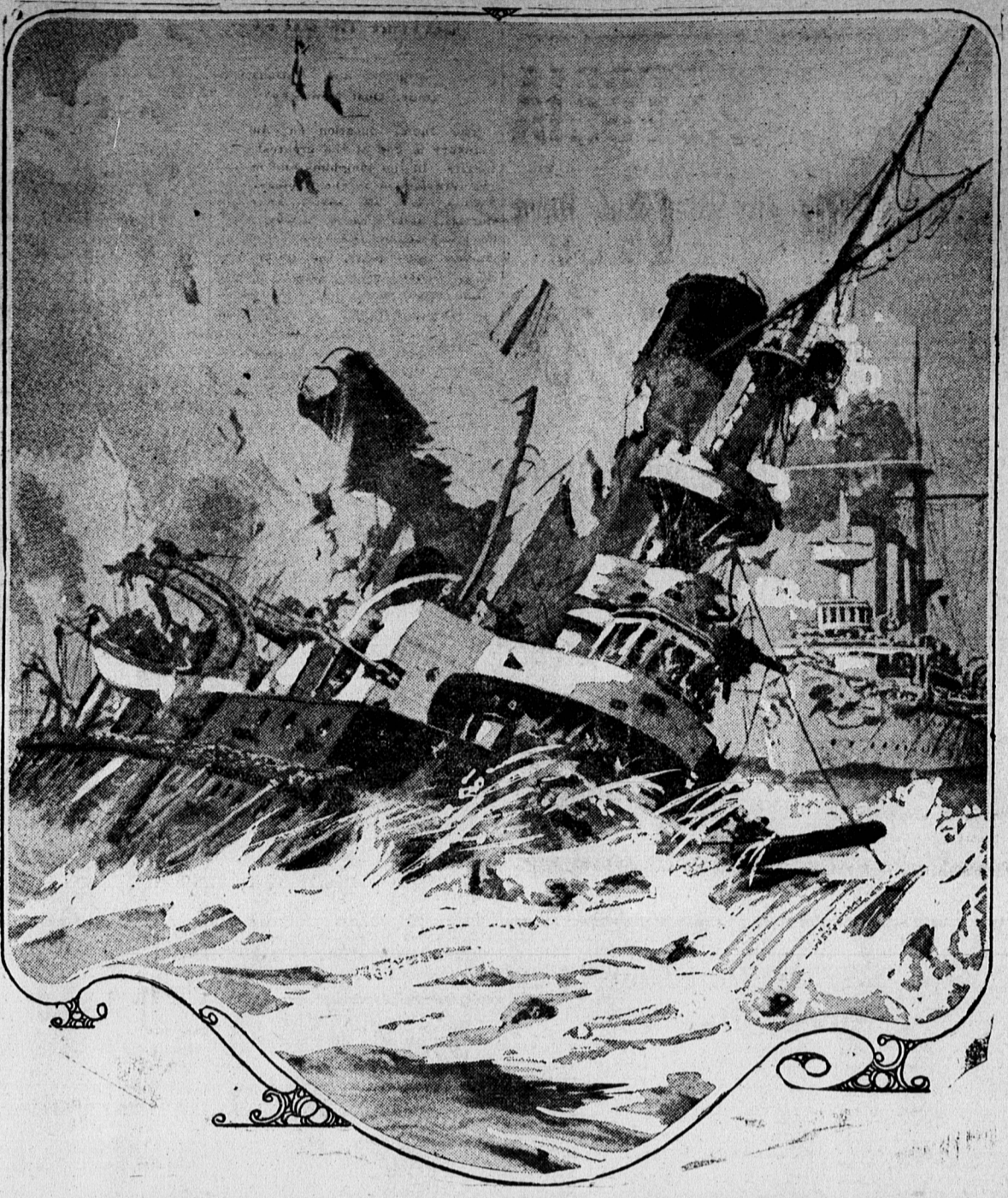
