A WARNING AGAINST THE CANADIAN PERIL.

In a remarkable article the New York Times recently warned its readers against the depletion of the farming population in the States by migration to Canada.

Of this latter number nearly 17,000 were Americans who had gone to Canada, and decided to return. During several years past the balance in the interchange on the whole has been against the States, and especially in farmers.

Further The Times quotes from Hon. Joseph E. Ransdell, a representative in Congress from Louisiana, whose patriotic soul has been stirred by a study of the migration statistics.

thirteen different States and went on to assert the seriousness of the loss, inasmuch as these migrating farmers with their wives and children were carrying away the equivalent of \$1,000 each while the immigrants coming to the States from abroad brought with them no more than an average of \$23 each.

It will be observed that the tone of both The Times and of Mr. Ransdell is by no means exultant as they contemplate the situation. They see in it no American invasion of Canada, no Americanisation of Canada, but a loss to the United States of so many of its best citizens and a corresponding gain to Canada.

CANADA HAS A GOOD YEAR.

Although the Northwest crops are not altogether up to earlier expectations, Canada is having a good yield of farm crops on the whole.

The entire country has 9,295,500 acres under wheat, of which 8,376,345 acres are in the Northwest, so largely has wheat cultivation shifted from the older Provinces to the prairies.

The Dominion has 9,864,100 acres under oats, and the estimated area of all the field crops is 30,554,200 acres.
