Shipping News

NO SUBSIDY FOR N. B. STEAMSHIP SERVICE.

In answer to a series of questions by Mr. Marcell Bonaventure, Sir George Foster, stated that the government did not intend to offer a subsidy this year for a steamship service between Campbellton, N. B., and Gaspe, Que. The government had granted the contract for a service between Montreal, Quebec, Gaspe and Paspébiac, Quebec to the St. Lawrence Shipping and Trading Company of Quebec.

PASSED SCHOONER BOTTOM UP.

C. H. Harvey, of the Marine & Fisheries, Halifax, received a sad message from Captain Holmes, of the steamer "Vasar", to the effect that at 4 p. m. Sunday he passed a wrecked schooner, bottom up, drifting north-east in lat. 41° 30' north, long. 59.54 west. The wreck is thought to have been the "Maid of LaHave" which was abandoned at sea.

ICE ON THE GREAT LAKES HEAVIER THAN IN 1919

Ice on the Great Lakes is much heavier than at this time last year, and in comparison with the 12 years' normal. There is an average thickness at Duluth and above the average at Sault Ste. Marie and at Escanaba, says the first ice report of the season, issued this evening by the local United States Weather Bureau. In Lake Ontario ice in harbors is heavy while ice fields are reported over the eastern and central portions. In Lake Erie the fields are solid along the south shore, and there is open water visible. Some open water is reported off Port Stanley. Ice is heavily winnowed.

In Lake Huron the fields are extensive and heavy, and extend beyond vision. St. Clair River is open for about two miles below the mouth of Lake Huron and heavily packed below this point to Lake St. Clair. The ice in Lake St. Clair is heavy and ranges from 22 to 28 inches in thickness. Detroit River is closed all the way to Lake Erie. St. Mary's River is solid and the entire length is covered with snow.

SEVERE STORM HITS

CITY OF QUEBEC

QUEBEC, March 14.—(By Canadian Press)—Quebec was struggling tonight to recover from the effects of one of the worst storms that ever struck the city. Every public utility service is demoralized and most of the city streets and houses were in darkness over Saturday night, while heavy damage has been done to trees, overhead wires and other equipment. After a twelve hour rain on Friday, the rain froze as soon as it fell and all wires, buildings and trees were covered with a thick coating of ice, bending the trees to within a few feet of the streets. About noon Saturday, a high wind sprang up with a heavy snow fall and completed the destruction. High power poles were broken down, leaving the city at night in darkness. All theatres except two were forced to close down and stores were served with candles. Papers were much reduced in size owing to the power shortage and on Sunday morning no cooking could be done since the gas ranges were out of business. Tonight lights came on in various parts of the city, but the street railway was still storm bound. The city of Levis also suffered severely in much the same way from the effects of the storm.
