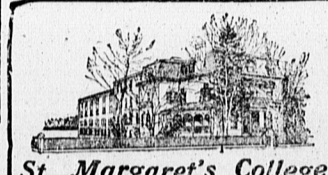
LIFE SAVERS' SEASON

DETROIT, Jan. 1—Aside from saving hundreds of lives and millions of dollars' worth of property in marine disasters, the United States life saving service managed to render assistance to many unfortunate persons in distress. During the last fiscal year there were 1,376 marine disasters, involving the lives of 8,900 persons, which called the life-saving service into activity. Seventy-two vessels were totally lost although only thirty people lost their lives in consequence. The total value of the property involved was \$16,106,080, the value of the property lost being \$2,295,380. Of the 1,374 vessels making disaster, the life-saving service rendered aid to 1,319, valued, with their cargo at \$13,316,815.
