FORMER AMBASSADOR TO MEXICO WHO MAY HOLD HIGH DIPLOMATIC POST



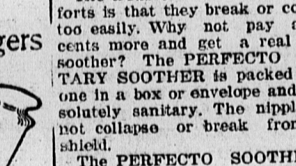
HENRY P. FLETCHER

HEAVY WOOL SHIPMENTS

What shipping men declared is to be a heavy movement of wool from Australia to the United States in anticipation of an early in creased tariff on that commodity has commenced. Five hundred bales of wool arrived on the steamer Tahiti. A shipment of 16,000 bales is aboard the Waihawa, due in San Francisco March 8. Other big shipments are expected within the next few weeks.

Embargo Causes Candidates Defeat

LONDON, March 4.—Sir Arthur Griffith-Boscawen, newly appointed Minister of Agriculture was defeated in the Dudley bye-election, the result of which was announced today, by J. Wilson, labor candidate. Voting was labor 10,244, coalition Liberal 9,968. Majority against 276. The defeat of the Government candidate is mainly attributed to a controversy over the question of the embargo on Canadian cattle used as an argument by opposition who ascribed this as the cause of the high cost of meat in Great Britain.



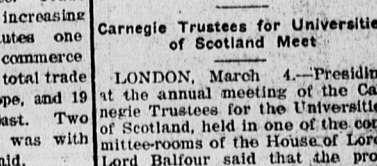
Legislature of Manitoba Urges Removal of Cattle Embargo

WINNIPEG, March 4.—Removal of the British embargo on Canadian cattle was unanimously urged by the legislature at this afternoon's session on the grounds that there is no disease on Canadian cattle which justifies the continuance of the ban and that the uncertainty as to future markets for live stock in the Dominion is having a paralyzing effect on the cattle raising industry of the West.

Grants Are Abused

LONDON, March 4.—Presiding at the annual meeting of the Carnegie Trustees for the Universities of Scotland, held in one of the committee-rooms of the House of Lords Lord Balfour said that the problem of continuing to pay in full the fees of students requiring assistance was giving the trustees great anxiety. The amount available was strictly limited, and he was satisfied that a great many were applying for assistance who could do without it. A general inquiry into the circumstances of applicants might have to be made. He referred with gratification to the increasing practice among former beneficiaries of paying back grants received during their studentship. The amount repaid last year was £1,295, and this was being put into a special fund for students who required not only fees but maintenance.
