Great Turf Rivals Reach Kenilworth For Final Trials

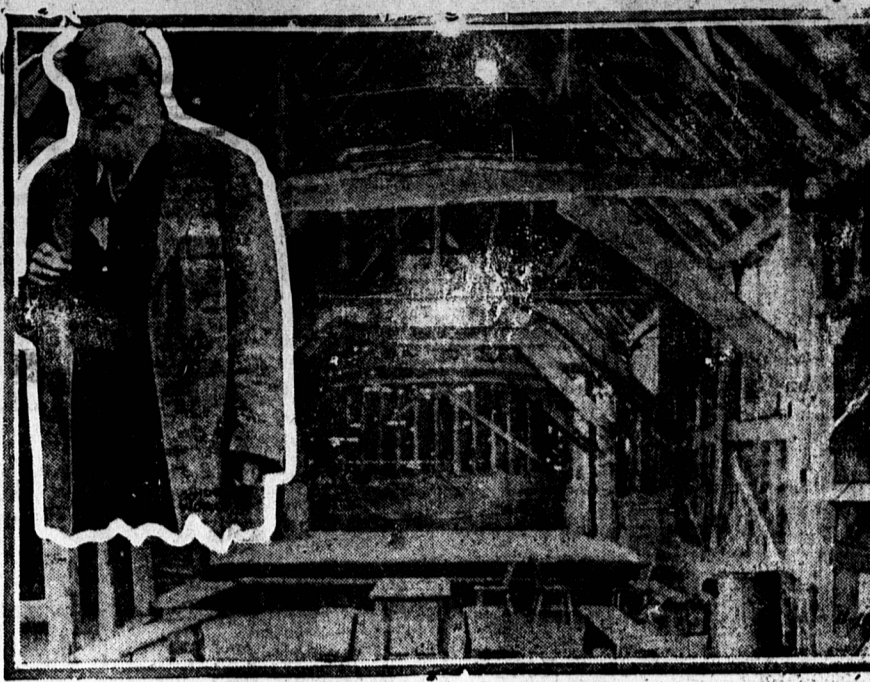
Canadian Horse is Under Protection of "Wolf" a Sturdy Police Dog Who Watches Every Movement

KENILWORTH RACE TRACK, WINDSOR, Oct. 9.—Racing at Kenilworth Park race course this afternoon was overshadowed by the arrival of Sir Barton, owned by Commander J. K. L. Ross, and Man O'War, owned by Samuel D. Riddle.

Sir Barton came from Laurel, where the stud of his own is situated, while Man O'War came from New York, having been recently stabled at Belmont Park, where he made a phenomenal trial before being shipped to the Canadian track.

Sir Barton was the first to arrive at Kenilworth track. He reached Windsor at noon and was unloaded in the stable.

Man O'War has only breezed since his trial at Belmont Park on Monday afternoon, when he went the journey of the race within one second of the record of 201 3/5 held jointly with Sir Barton for the Saratoga course.

Trainer Feustel stated that Man O'War's trial on Monday had pleased him and that the horse carried the weight he will have to shoulder in the meeting with Sir Barton.

The horses are now stabled in quarters erected for them by the management of the Kenilworth race track. The stables are furnished with overhangs, under which the horses can be walked regardless of the weather conditions. The stables are surrounded by a double fence, one as a protection for the overhangs and the other to keep the public out. The stables are guarded by Pinkerton men, one man being stationed at each corner of the square yards surrounding the places where the horses are housed.

MAN O'WAR FAVORED.

Both horses have a strong following here, although at the present time Man O'War is an odds-on favorite at 4 to 5. This will be the first time he has raced out of his own division, and Sir Barton's admirers freely express the opinion that this will be a disadvantage to the three-year-old.

On the other hand, Sir Barton has met and defeated horses of all ages, his greatest victory, according to his trainer, being in an event for three-year-olds and upward. With the continued fine weather of the past few days extra care has been given to the track which is now in record-breaking condition. The track is being cared for by James Southard, who prepared the track at Syracuse for the harness racing during which several records were lowered in yester-years. The hotels in Detroit are even now well filled up, while parties are arriving on almost every train, so that by the week-end the accommodation at both Detroit and Windsor will be taxed to overflowing.
