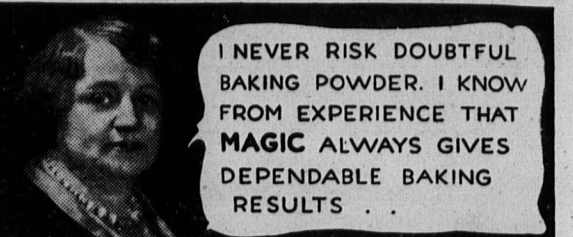

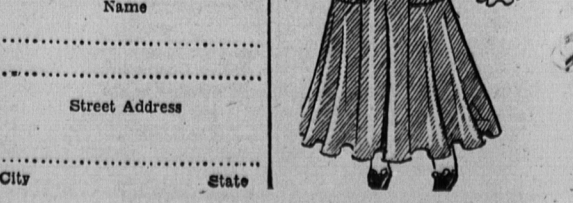

"I dare say you think I'm a prune!" said Barstowe more lightly.



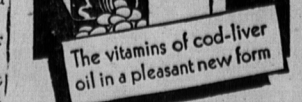
