Livestock

MONTREAL, March 23 (CP)—Cattle receipts on Montreal livestock market today totaled 490, with prices steady on all grades of livestock. Good steers were nominally quoted at \$10 to \$10.75 and medium at \$9.50, with common from \$8.50 to \$8.50. Good heifers sold for \$9.50, medium \$8 to \$9.50 and common up to \$7.50. Fed calves or baby heaves ranged from \$10 and \$11.50. Good cows were \$7.75 to \$8.25, medium \$6.50 to \$7.50 and common \$6 to \$6.50. Canners and cutters were from \$4.50 to \$6. Bulls ranged from \$6 to \$8.50.

MONTREAL EXCHANGE

MONTREAL, March 23 (CP)—Pressure on Abitibi issues featured trading today on the stock exchange and curb market. In the balance of transactions an irregular tone prevailed, with some strength being displayed by Quebec electric. Abitibi six per cent preferred slipping a point and the common five cents as a curb market reaction to the decision of the Ontario Appeal Court dismissing an appeal against a judgment authorizing the sale of the company's assets. Montreal Power and Shawinigan worked up fractionally in utilities on the stock exchange but Bell Telephone was down a bit. Hudson Bay Mining was lower in metals and McColl-Fontenac was shaded in oils. Dominion Bridge was improved in industrials and the St. Lawrence Corporation issues and Hamilton Bridge dropped back. In miscellaneous Distillers-Beagram and Regent Knitting preference were stronger spots and Celanese, Fenelon Players, Industrial Acceptance, Ogilvie Flour and Montreal Telegraph gave ground. Total sales: 11,600 shares; Industrials, 8,700; Mines, 2,900; Bonds \$1,000.

Hitler, who often does the unexpected, is expected this time to push east for oil, perhaps even to India to attempt a junction with the Japs. Despite the war prophets' predictions, Hitler spent a quiet winter, didn't drive to Gibraltar or Dakar, strike at Suez, invade England, or thrust into the Caucasus and beyond. The axis war machine was unusually idle in Europe, perhaps resting up, repairing and conserving oil for a spring offensive. After three months on the defensive, Hitler may be ready to attack, but whether he will strike in the Caucasus, at Turkey, at Britain or elsewhere on the map is his secret.'

Allied counter-offensives, like the RAF raids on Germany and Italy, British fleet action in the Mediterranean were attacks in Russia and Tibet were how the axis from embarking on the potential spring campaigns shown on map.
