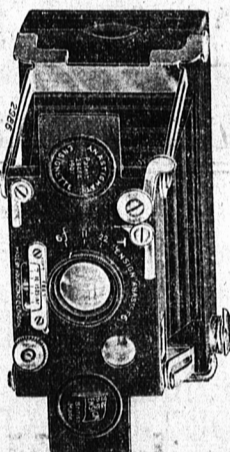

Robinson Black, Organizer and Instructor of Cadet Corps for the Maritime Provinces, carried out the annual inspection of the St. Dunstan's College Cadet Corps on Monday morning, May 29th. In view of the short time he has for the perfecting of the boys in the drill, the instructor, Mr. Russell Smith, is to be congratulated on the smartness of his recruits. The O. and I.C.C. made a few complimentary remarks at the close of the inspection, and these were well received by the Cadets, as was also the gratification granted by the college authorities. After the inspection, Capt. Black left for Summerside, on his way to visit the New Brunswick corps. He will return to complete the inspection of the various school Cadet Corps.

OVERSEAS BATTERY—No. 6 Siege Artillery (McGill) with headquarters at Stratheona, Halk, Sherbrooke Street West, has a few posts vacant for men not connected with the university. The total complement is 159 of all ranks. An extraordinary fine class of men have enlisted and it is thought that this will be one of the best units which will go overseas from Canada. In view of the nature of the work of a siege battery, the physical standard required is somewhat higher than the average. Fifty men have already been sent to Halifax to undergo a special course of training in artillery warfare. On Sunday morning the battery will hold its first Sunday parade. There will be a service for the men and their friends and relatives at 9.45 a. m. in the David Morrice Hall of the Presbyterian College, when the Rev. Dr. Fraser will give an address.
