## SHOT FATHER TO PREVENT MARRIAGE

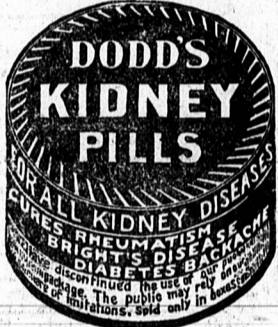
### Aged Merchant Who Was to Wed Young Girl Killed by His Son.

The father was a member of the large wholesale drug firm of Weaver & Sterry, with a place of business at 166 Pearl street. He was engaged to be married to a young school teacher of Brooklyn, and his engagement had caused serious family quarrels.

## GREAT TROTTER TODD IS DEAD.

### One of America's Greatest Harness Horses Has Passed Out.

NEW YORK, May 20.—Todd, considered by horsemen to have been one of the greatest of trotting horses on the American turf, died Sunday of pneumonia, at the stock farm of Wm. C. Bradley, near Somerville, N. J. He was bred by J. Malcolm Forbes, of Boston in 1899, and was by Bergen-Farnella. Among his brilliant get are Kentucky Derby, and other rich stakes, Cochato Douglas and Sir Todd. Nine of his fifteen three year olds last year made a record under 2.18 1-2. Todd was bought by Mr. Bradley at the Old Glory Horse Sale here last fall, the price paid for him being \$80,000.

## GIRL'S MIND UPSET BY BURGLAR JOKE

### Scared by Apartment House Employee, Removed to Bellevue Hospital.

NEW YORK, May 20.—Hysterical and possibly insane, Annie Milliker, nineteen years old was removed to Bellevue Hospital yesterday. Her condition, it is alleged, is the result of practical jokes played upon her by employees in the apartment house a week ago. She was employed there as a servant in the family of Carl and Schrader. A week ago, when left at home with the children at night, employees in the house pretended to be burglars and demanded admittance to the apartment. The girl was so thoroughly scared that she was unable to work during the week following, and went to the Elberg home. There, in recounting the story of the supposed burglars, she was overcome with terror, and had to be restrained from leaping from the window.

## ANOTHER, BIG C. B. INDUSTRY

### Has Raised Enough Money to Start the National Rolling Mills.

SYDNEY, May 20.—Interest in the National Rolling Mills is revived by the return to the city of C. V. Wetmore and F. A. Crowell, the chief movers, from a mission to the upper provinces undertaken on behalf of the project. Mr. Wetmore returned on Friday and Mr. Crowell on Saturday night. It is understood that the mission of the promoters has on the whole been successful. Arrangements have been completed whereby construction of the plant will be undertaken without delay, pending the completion of a satisfactory arrangement with the city. The project according to the promoters has been regarded by investors favorably from the outset, in fact it is one of the best propositions of its kind in Canada, and it was only because of the condition of the money market that the rolling mills in common with many like propositions had been temporarily suspended. The money market has now turned the corner and gradual improvement may be looked forward to.

## COMRADESHIP NOT MARRIAGE

### Cincinnati Professor Has Startling Views—Love is Not Essential.

CINCINNATI, May 20.—Professor H. Heath Bowden, whose resignation as professor of philosophy at the University of Cincinnati has been remanded by President Dabney, because of Professor Bowden's private views on marriage and sociology, was at his post as usual today, his classes being well attended. He will not be suspended at present.  
As Professor Bowden has made a protest again, handing in his resignation, President Dabney says he is disposed to give him a fair hearing. Professor Bowden today gave a long statement of his case, including his views on marriage. After expressing faith in the American public's judgment and his willingness to abide by it, he says in substance: "I believe in freedom of association of the sexes in marriage based on comradeship. The only limit I would impose on sexual promiscuity would be the esthetic ideal of comradeship on the moral side and the necessary restrictions of sturpiculture on the physical side."  
He approves of marriage but insists that comradeship rather than love is the essential.  
He "derogates the finality of marriage and social stigma which attaches to divorce," and "believes with Plato that the state should subsidize maternity. I believe that the individual and not the family is the proper unit of political and social organization," he says.

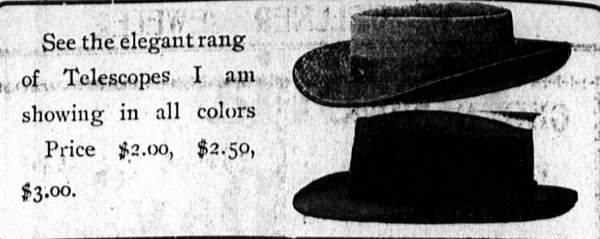
