MARY MCLEOD, UIGG

Born on the McLeod farm at Uigg Feb. 7th, 1841, and passing away on January 24th, the late Mary McLeod had almost reached the ripe age of 78 years.

She was the daughter of the late Rev. Samuel McLeod for many years a beloved and faithful pastor of the Uigg Baptist Church.

Under such Christian guidance she was reared, and her faithful adherence to Christian principles was the result of the traditions and training of pious ancestors.

Of a family of six but one survives her, Norman S. of Montague Sarah wife of William McLeod of Bridgetown, and her brothers Duncan C. Dr. James McLeod and Malcom S. passed on before her.

Her home with the widow of the latter Mr. M. S. McLeod and here she died, on the old farm now owned by her nephew S. E. McLeod.

She had been ill but a short time when the "house where she tabernacled was dissolved" that she might enter the "house not made with hands."

Funeral services were held at the home January 28th conducted by the pastor of the Orwell Presbyterian Church. She was laid away in the family plot in Uigg Cemetery near the church which to her had many sacred memories.

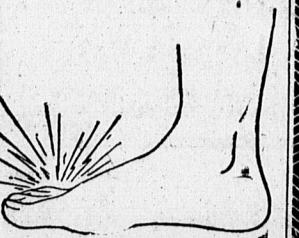

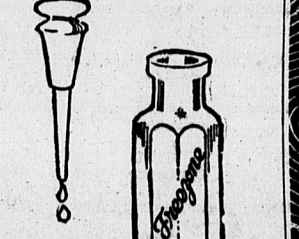

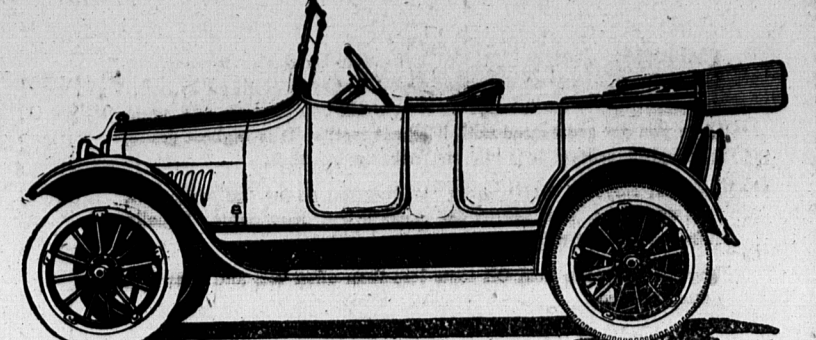
