S. Robertson, Kingsborough. She was accompanied by Miss Martha Stewart of Lot 48.—Messrs McLean & McLean, have added a hand saw to their ever increasing plant and are better prepared than ever to attend to the wants of their summer patrons.—A. W. Bruce, has engaged in butchering and supplies a large district north and east with his well known products.—All hands are engaged in digging. The potato crop is short and the starch factory in East Baltic will not get the usual quantity.
