A letter from Premier Farquharson received last evening will appear in tomorrow's GUARDIAN with a reply thereto.

A case suspiciously like smallpox is reported on board a schooner in Georgetown harbor. It may not be smallpox but it should be with due precautions taken the disease need not be permitted to reach the land. The situation calls for every precaution but should not excite needless alarm.

THE GUARDIAN learns of three or four aspirants for the representation of the West River district in the Legislature in succession to Premier Farquharson. It will no doubt require a convention to decide between them. According to some of the precedents recently laid down the successful candidate ought at least to think himself good enough for Cabinet timber with a possible "clinch" on the Premiership itself. Already several of the aspirants are busy not only with reasons why they should be chosen, but reasons why the other fellows should be left at home.

The Trans-Siberian Railway just now completed has been spoken of as a continuation of the Canadian Pacific. Our great trans-continental railway crosses North America between the 45th and 50th parallels of latitude. It is very much in the same latitude that the Siberian railway takes its way from Moscow to Vladivostok, the old Russian capital being situated about latitude 55 and Vladivostok about latitude 43. Thus the two railways are fairly well in line, with each other and with their steamship connections on the Atlantic and Pacific afford greater facilities than ever were known before for a quick and comfortable trip around the globe.

All of the upwards of forty cases of smallpox that have been noted so far in Saint John originated with one man who came to the city and after being taken ill was sent to the Public Hospital. While there he broke out with the disease, infecting a number of the nurses and hospital patients before he was removed to the Epidemic Hospital where he died. It became necessary to place the Public Hospital in quarantine and since then 16 houses about the town have also been quarantined, with 32 guards employed to prevent intercourse. The disease may come to us in Charlottetown some day, and yet we have no provision for an epidemic Hospital. The terrible experience of this city sixteen years ago, and present threatening conditions ought to move the City Council to awake from their lethargy.

Li Hung Chang believed in the doctrine transmigration of souls, in common with other Buddhists. And there is a writer in the Toronto World tells of an interview with him which the writer was bound not to make public till after the Chinese statesman's death. That obstacle being removed the story is told. The interviewer asked the great statesman the blunt question "Why did you love Gordon," and it is alleged he replied, "Why do you ask?" After some parrying the answer was, "I loved Gordon with a peculiar touch of fear, and General Grant without any reservation whatever, because in our past lives, the latest of which I well remember, we were brothers in one family." Further the interviewer was told that they were "warriors," and that Gordon was the eldest and ruled the others generally by love but sometimes by fear.

The French Government pays bounties on shipping in various forms amounting to \$4,000,000 a year and yet the French shipping industry is not prospering. How large these bounties are is shown by the London Economist, being 60 francs per ton for iron and steel ships, and 40 francs per ton for wooden ships, with an additional bounty for engines and boilers. The Government bounty on a 10,000 ton steel steamer would run up to \$130,000, exclusive of what is paid on engines and boilers, and on a 1,000 ton wooden ship the bounty would be \$8,000. In addition to this operative bounties are paid per ton per thousand miles sailed. Shipping bounties in various forms have been running in France during twenty years past, and the tendency is to increase rather than diminish them, but with all these stimulants the registered tonnage of France is barely one-tenth of that of the United Kingdom.
