THE DECLINE OF CANADIAN SHIPPING.

One of the most remarkable features in connection with the history of the Dominion is the marked contrast between the rapid and vast development in agriculture, trade, industry, transportation and mining, and the decay of Canadian shipping.

In 1878 there were upon the shipping registers of the Dominion 7,169 vessels, aggregating 1,333,058 tons. That was the maximum of Canadian tonnage yet achieved.

By this remarkable decline the shipping of the Maritime Provinces was alarmingly diminished, from a total of 943,583 tons in 1878 to 219,474 tons at the end of 1910.

It is noteworthy that when Canadian shipping was at its best in 1878, of the one and one-third million tons registered, 943,583 tons, or two-thirds of the total, belonged in the three Provinces by the sea.

Here are the figures showing the registered shipping tonnage of the three Provinces as it was in 1878 and 1910 respectively:

1878 1910

New Brunswick . . . 325,965 59,637

Nova Scotia . . . 553,368 149,737

P. E. Island . . . 54,250 10,108

Total . . . 943,583 219,474

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A glance at these figures will show that New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island have each lost over four-fifths of the tonnage they had in 1878, while Nova Scotia has lost upwards of two-thirds of what she then possessed.

Various causes have been contributed to produce this result. The former Canadian ships were mostly sailing vessels, built of wood. Steel has taken the place of wood and steam has taken the place of sails to a very large extent since 1878.

PROVINCIAL AFFAIRS. The Provincial Government have apparently decided to bring on the by-elections in the two vacant seats, as they have the undoubted constitutional right to do.

The policy and conduct of the Government in office must come under review before the electorate at a by-election the same as in a general contest. This involves all the preparation for attack and defence and almost the same amount of time and disturbance to business in one case as the other.

It is obvious that if the local contests are to be brought on in Port Augustus and Belfast, the convenience of the electors and the politicians as well will be best served by holding them before the stormy and inclement weather of the late fall or early winter comes on, when the roads are often at their worst.

The Guardian has never favored the interlocking of federal and provincial parties, believing that each should be independent of the other, and that we have little need of party lines in our provincial affairs.

The Government party here, one result of which is that Mr. Palmer's Government suffers somewhat in prestige and influence by the defect of the Laurier Government.

Very probably had present conditions been foreseen so much stress would not have been laid by the local Government party on the advantages of a federal alliance.



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
