Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. Homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 40 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section on alone his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 30 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years cultivate 20 acres and erect a house worth \$200.

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivar on under certain conditions.

ISLAND GRADUATES FROM THE MONTREAL PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Talks Interestingly Of Co-operative Theological Colleges And the Significance of the Movement.

Reverend George Cameron who graduated this year from the Montreal Presbyterian College, and who is a Licentiate from the Presbytery of Montreal, has arrived in the city.

Mr. Cameron is the first Island graduate within recent years from the Montreal College which is affiliated with McGill University, and now forms one of the four co-operating theological colleges of that city. The Presbyterian, Diocesan, Wesleyan, and Congregational Colleges of Montreal have set an example in the way of denominational affiliation and co-operation which has been very favorably commented upon in this country and Great Britain. They have by their close and practical co-operation inaugurated a movement which will be the greatest factor of the future tending towards denominational union. Montreal has shown its very hearty appreciation and approval of this collegiate co-operation by subscribing nearly \$600,000 for the erection and equipment of a Divinity Hall to be used by the four co-operative theological colleges. This money came largely from Montreal's most prominent business men. At present the joint lectures of the four co-operating theological colleges are given in a central building on University Street, temporarily used as a Divinity Hall, until the erection of the new building. There the students of the four different denominational colleges take the greater part of their work in common classes, and from different denominational professors. The system has abundantly justified itself, having proven a splendid success.

The joint Faculty of the co-operating colleges forms the largest purely theological faculty on the continent, and one of the strongest, the students coming under the instruction of some of the foremost scholars in the world of religious thought.

Mr. Cameron comes to the bedside of his mother, who is ill in the Prince Edward Island Hospital. He is a son of Mr. John Cameron, Bayfield St., and a brother of Sergeant Robert W. Cameron of the 16th Canadian Scottish.

British Winning In the Sudan

ATHENS, May 25—Exceptional military activity at Salonki is believed here to portend developments of great importance. General Powell, chief of the British staff, and other officers of the Allies, who have been on leave in Athens, have been recalled suddenly.

On May 13, Bulgaria was reported to be sending heavy reinforcements to the Salonki front in anticipation of a general offensive by the Allies. Since that time, despatches from various sources have reported activity on the part of the French and British forces, the most notable being the occupation of Florina, eighteen miles south of Monastir, by Allied troops on May 23.

Significance was also attached to the efforts of the Entente to obtain the use of the Greek railroad, for the transportation of the reorganized Serbian army, to the Salonki front. Paris and London have been persistently silent as to any developments in the Balkans.

ATHENS, May 26—The agitation throughout Greece, caused by the news that Teutonic submarines had torpedoed three Greek vessels, continues

LONDON, May 26—The war office tonight issued a report covering the fighting to May 23 in the Sudan, which resulted in the defeat of some 3,000 troops of Ali Dinar, Sultan of Darfur, by Colonel Kelley's force. The fight took place at El Fasher. The British losses are given as five men killed and 25 wounded while the losses to the Sultan's force are estimated at 1,000. The Sulfin whose attitude toward the Sudanese Gov't for a long time has been truculent, is reported to have fled with a small number of his followers.

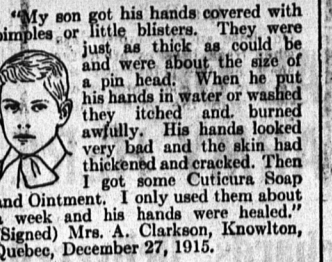
