### THE WIRELESS RECORD BEATEN

Operator at Cape Breton While Testing Caught Message From Manila.

SYDNEY, Oct. 8—While Marconi experts were trying the new receiving cones to day at the top of the towers at the station at Morion, the operator below picked up a wireless message at Manila, in the South Pacific. The message received was that the American cruiser Philadelphia had arrived there safe. The Marconi people account for the strange happening by the theory that the cone at Manila must have been in perfect tune with that at Morion. The best previous record for distance was 4,000 miles, between Savannah and a warship in the South Pacific.

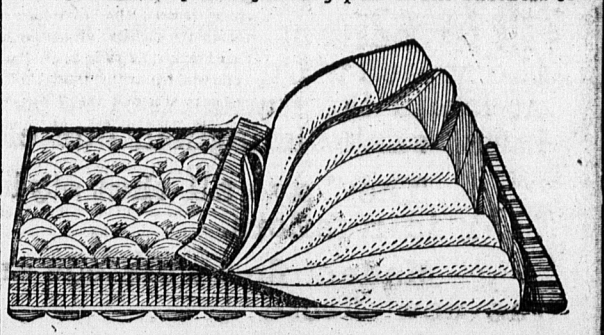
