BRINGS GREAT GOLD TALES FROM ALASKA.

NEW YORK, Nov. 21.—Bringing a tale of a land where gold is more plentiful than it is in Alaska, Christian Leden, a young Swedish explorer, has returned to this city after three years spent in the Arctic. As evidence of the truth of his story, he has a harpoon head hammered out of gold by the natives of a camp since wiped out by disease. He has also several spears of gold-bearing quartz brought to him by Eskimos who dared many dangers in order to get them. Leden said he had visited a land where the ground was so full of gold that in the warm months the smell of it filled the air.

Mr. Leden's explorations carried him over thousands of miles in the country northwest of Hudson Bay. He went alone, and lived and traveled with the natives. His outfit was shipped by boat to Fort Churchill on Hudson Bay, which was the starting point of his travels.

Just where the gold and oil are Mr. Leden, who is now at the Waldorf Astoria, will not say. The place where the gold is to be found he did not visit, because to have done so, he said, would have meant another two years in the far north. "The territory was described to him by some Eskimos, who told him of a great hill that had been so split that the different strata were uncovered. Here the reddish yellow metal could be seen. Mr. Leden persuaded some of those journeying north to search out the place."

NEW YORK, Nov. 18.—Frederick Palmer, the war correspondent designated by the British war office to represent the entire press of the United States, returning today on the steamer Nieuw Amsterdam for a rest before going back to the front. It is Mr. Palmer's opinion that the allied offensive against the Germans in the battle of the Somme will end only when the war itself ends, that it will be continued for two, perhaps three years.

Of the work of the tanks at the front Mr. Palmer spoke in highest praise, saying that their charges upon the trenches has saved thousands of lives.

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

The sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions.

100—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land, in each of three years.

150—Homeowner may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

A settler who has exhausted his homesteaded land in certain districts. Price \$1.00 per acre. Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.
