MAY CONTROL BICYCLE BUSINESS OF CANADA.

TORONTO, November 7.—Negotiations are proceeding toward the amalgamation of two large bicycle corporations, incorporated a year ago, the Canada Cycle and Motor Company Limited, and the National Cycle and Automobile Company, Limited. If the deal is effected the corporation will practically control the bicycle business in Canada. The Canada Cycle and Motor Company is capitalized at two and a half millions, and the National at two millions.

A MOST GALLANT AMERICAN.

In the death of Charles Dudley Warner, the United States has lost one of its foremost authors. He was one of the most charming American essayists, and his work will have of place in English literature. Mr. Warner visited Cape Breton many years ago, one result of his visit being his quaint and humorous book, "Baddeck and That Sort of Thing," which first introduced Baddeck and the glories of the Bras D'Or to the American public.

LAST WISHES OF PRINCE VICTOR.

A despatch from Pretoria, says that Prince Christian Victor, a grandson of the Queen who died yesterday of enteric fever, expressed a wish that he should be buried with his comrades in South Africa. His body will, therefore, probably be interred at Pretoria. The Prince was a Major in the King's Royal Rifles.

CUNECATS AT CANTON.

HONG KONG, Nov. 6.—The presence of eleven gunboats at Canton causes continued speculation. The action of a German vessel reported to be sounding in the vicinity of Honan and Fati has caused rumor that the Germans intend to obtain a concession.

RUSSIA ANNEXES

China Territory by Right of Conquest

POWERS WILL PROTEST

And Insist on Severe Punishment for Chinese Outrages.

RUSSIA'S BOLD GAME.

TIEN TSIN, Nov. 8.—(Special).—Russia has formally annexed, by right of conquest a large tract including the railway plant and best arsenal on the river side opposite the English and German settlements.

Strong protests from the powers are expected.

PUNISHMENT FOR BOXERS.
