The Lord Bishop of Nova Scotia held an ordination at All Saints' Cathedral Sunday morning when F. W. Florence, Westville, was made Deacon, and Russell Langston, Musquodoboit, C. H. Talmage, Prince Edward Island and William Hubbard, Arichat, C. B., were advanced to the priesthood. The candidates were presented by Rev. C. W. Vernon, one of the Bishop's examining chaplains. The Litany was sung by Dean Crawford, Cannon Hill, and Rev. W. Driffield, Bishop as chaplain. Rev. W. Driffield, Rector of Digby, preached an able sermon on the work and responsibilities of the Sacred Ministry. The Bishop celebrated Holy Communion assisted by the Dean, Rev. W. Driffield and A. W. Nicholl. The special music was admirably sung by the Cathedral choir under the direction of the organist, G. E. Austen. The ordination of the priests was especially impressive, the ceremony being performed by the laying on of the Bishop's hands together with the laying on of the hands of the attendant presbytery as described in the New Testament.
