Not many petitions were filed in any of the Provinces and the total number was less than has been usual after a general election in the Dominion.

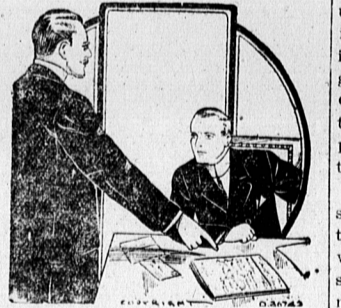
