BIG WARSHIP LAUNCHED.

GLASGOW, Nov. 22.—The Sutej, the first of the four new armored cruisers of the Cressy class now building for the British Government, was launched at the Clydebank yards of John Brown & Co., Saturday. Notwithstanding the thick, cold fog that made the day a nasty one to be about, an immense crowd watched the ceremony.

The Sutej is a vessel of 12,000 tons displacement. Its engine, led by 80 Belleville boilers, are from the works of the Clydebank Company and are capable of developing 21,000 indicated horse-power. The armor belt is of six-inch Krupp steel and the vessel will carry two 9.2-inch, twelve 6-inch and seventeen smaller quick-firing guns.

Sankey Prays For Moody.

POUGAKEPSAIE, Nov. 21.—Ira Sankey, the singing evangelist and former associate of Dwight L. Moody, conducted services in the Rescue Mission here last night, in the course of which he offered a fervent prayer for the recovery of Mr. Moody, and said: "If pleases God otherwise, may he have abundantly glorious entrance into heaven."

Mr. Sankey prayed that the wheels of the car bearing Mr. Moody to his home and family at Northfield should move softly, and that his health might be restored to him to take up his work where he laid it down.

Wm. Bryan Will be the Man.

CHICAGO, Nov. 22.—The Democratic national campaign for 1900 was practically inaugurated today, when the members of the National Democratic Executive Committee met in secret session at the Sherman House.

Senator Jones, the chairman, voiced the sentiment of all the committeemen present when he said that silver, imperialism and trusts would be the main issues, and that Bryan, without any doubt, would be the nominee. Senator Jones would not discuss the relative importance of the three future planks, saying that this depended entirely upon the section of the country in which the latter was up for discussion.

A Palace In Japan.

CHICAGO, Ill., Nov. 21.—Chicago engineers are designing the earthquake-proof steel palace for the Crown Prince of Japan, which is to mark the advent of American steel construction in the Mikado's land and the imperial government has appropriated \$3,000,000 for its erection.
